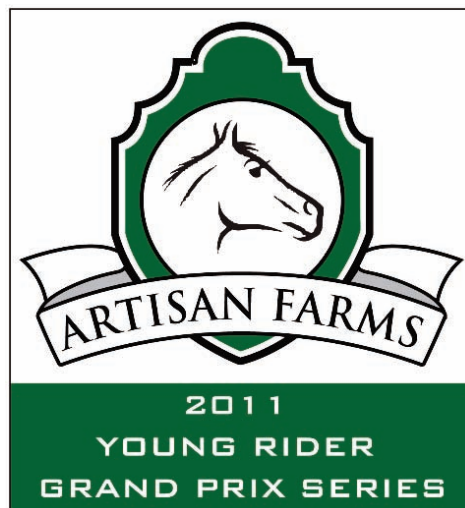


UPDATED SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE ARTISAN FARMS  
YOUNG RIDERS GRAND PRIX SERIES  
ALL CLASSES ARE QUALIFIERS FOR THE EY SUPER FINAL  
IN GERMANY



\* THE EY CUP WILL HAVE THEIR SUPER-FINAL IN LEIPZIG GERMANY IN 2011. 20 RIDERS AGES 25 AND YOUNGER WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE. 16 EUROPEAN RIDERS AND 3 RIDERS FROM THE 4 YOUNG RIDER EVENTS AT WEF WILL QUALIFY TO COMPETE IN THE SUPER FINAL. 2011 WEF WILL OFFER THREE (3) YOUNG RIDER GRAND PRIX AND ONE TEAM EVENT. RIDERS WHO HAVE COMPETED ON A NATIONS CUP TEAM AT A CSIO 3\* OR HIGHER OR IN A GRAND PRIX AT CSI 5\* OR IN A GRAND PRIX AT CSI-W 4\* OR HIGHER ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE. A MAXIMUM OF 2 HORSES PER RIDER IS ALLOWED IN THE QUALIFIERS. ONLY ONE HORSE PER RIDER IS ALLOWED AT THE SUPER-FINAL. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE FOR THE QUALIFICATIONS THEN THE RIDER WITH THE MOST CLEAR ROUNDS WILL QUALIFY. IF THERE IS STILL A TIE THEN THE HIGHEST PLACED RIDER IN CLASS 99 ON SUNDAY 20TH MARCH WILL QUALIFY.

Participation: Limited to two (2) horses per rider. You must declare your Point horse at the time of declaring and that horse must go first in the order of go. **Declarations to compete must be made 2 days before the class. For this class you MUST declare by Friday the 11th of February by 4:00 PM.** For riders to be considered a Young Rider you must have been born after (not earlier than) January 1, 1985. Points accrued will go with the rider and not the horse/rider combination. In accordance with JP112.A, the horses' names are drawn individually, starting with the first position and then working down.

**Class Rules** Horses who are entered in this class must be on the show grounds 24 hours before the start of the class. Check in will be from 8:00 am - 9:00 am on Saturday March 19th at the Stadium. Exhibitors must bring their horse and back number to the Vet Building located on the North Grounds. You must provide the steward with your stall assignment and location. **You must remain on the grounds until the completion of the class.**

Obstacles: Height 1.45 meters (4'9"), spreads to 5'3" - min. not including water jump

Speed: 375 m/min. (USEF National Standard)

The qualifying of the three riders for the EY Cup will be based on the following formula and will carry through all Young Rider events **except** the team event. The Scores for the First Round will be as follows:

Clear Round= 10 points	Four Faults= 4 points
Less than 4 Faults= 6 points	More than 4 Faults= 0 points

Points will be awarded to the 12 riders that place in this order:

1st- 12 Points, 2nd- 11 Points, 3rd- 10 Points, 4th- 9 Points, 5th- 8 Points, 6th- 7 Points, 7th- 6 Points, 8th- 5 Points, 9th- 4 Points, 10th- 3 Points, 11th- 2 Points, 12th- 1 Point

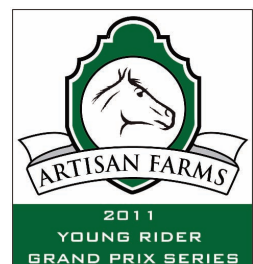

**WEF 9- March 9-13, 2011**

**98 \$20,000 Artisan Farms Young Rider Team Event \*EY Qualifier- To be held at night under the lights**

All Inclusive Entry Fee: \$400 (no Nomination if only doing this class) Nomination Fee: See page 1 of Jumper Section

Class Specifications: This is a team competition for Young Riders. USEF Zones may field as many teams as they wish. Zones who are unable to field a team may form a joint team and riders from other countries may form either a national team or a mixed team. In the event that a rider cannot find a team he/she may still compete for a ranking points score. Each team must consist of at least 3 riders and no more than four riders. Those teams that only have 3 riders will not have the benefit of a drop score. If a rider or riders cannot field a team the management may put together teams at their sole discretion. If a rider is unable to compete on a team then they will be permitted to compete for ranking points only. For riders to be considered a Young Rider you must have been born after (Not earlier than) January 1, 1985. **Teams must be declared by 4pm on Tuesday March 8th.**

**Special WEF Class Rules**

Horses who are entered in this class must be on the show grounds 24 hours before the start of the class. The Check in will be from 4PM to 5PM on Wednesday March 9th . Exhibitors must bring their horse and back number to the Vet Building located on the North Grounds. You must provide the steward with your stall assignment and location.

**You must remain on the grounds until the completion of the class**

For teams with 4 riders the rider's score with the highest number of faults will be dropped. For those teams with 3 riders all of the scores will be calculated.

This class will take place on Thursday Night March 10th

This class will be held using the Nations Cup format.

Course: A minimum of 12 obstacles will be used.

Obstacles: Height 1.45 meters (4'9"),spreads to 5'3" - min. not including water jump

Speed: 375 m/min. (USEF National Standard)

Order of go will be determined by a draw

Order of starting: The starting order for the teams in round one will be determined by the team. All number ones start first in succession, then all the number twos and so on. Those teams comprising only three riders may choose which three positions out of the four they will start.

The starting order for the second round will be in the reverse order of total penalties in the first round of the best three riders from each team. In case of equal penalties the teams will retain the starting order of the first round. Riders in each team start in the same order of the first round.

Placing will be based on the number of penalties from the first round added to the number of penalties in the second round. Teams with an equal number of penalties will remain tied.

Prize Money: \$20,000

First Place, \$3000 per rider, Second Place \$1250 per rider, Third Place \$750 per rider.

**Riders will receive the points listed below based on their individual performance in each of their rounds. Because this team event is based on Nations Cup Format, no extra points are awarded for final individual placings.**

Clear Round= 10 points  
Four Faults= 4 points

Less than 4 Faults= 6 points  
More than 4 Faults= 0 points

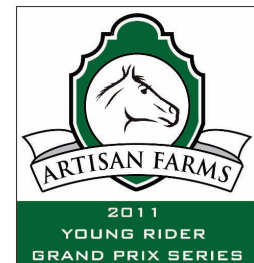
